In 2026, Tyrolean artist Kaspar Laurenz planted three apple trees in public spaces as part of his project Tree of 100 Apple Blossoms. The trees are located in Going am Wilden Kaiser, Kitzbühel and Ambras Castle Park in Innsbruck.

The plantings mark the beginning of a long-term art project. From 2027 onwards, the trees will gradually be grafted with different, mainly old apple varieties from the surrounding area. Over the years, each tree is intended to carry several varieties, producing different blossoms in spring and different apples in autumn. The number of varieties is deliberately not fixed and will depend on how each tree develops.

The tree in Kitzbühel will be continued as a joint project with Kitzbühel Primary School. School classes will be able to follow the development of the tree over the years and take part in the annual grafting and documentation. In this way, the children can learn directly from the tree about different apple varieties, their origins and the technique of grafting.

The trees are not conceived as finished artworks at the time of planting. They will continue to develop year by year. Growth, pruning, new grafts and also the success or failure of individual grafts will become part of the project.
